

THE PARENTS' AGREEMENT

As a parent, I commit to:

1. Ensure my child attends school daily, prepared, well-rested and arrives on time with school supplies.
2. Obtain relevant textbooks required for appropriate courses.
3. Provide my child with a quiet area to complete his schoolwork.
4. Support the teacher and ensure the completion of all homework assignments.
5. Attend parent/teacher conferences, scheduled open houses and parent fairs as needed.
6. Ensure my child respects all school property.
7. Ensure that school has my most current contact information such a cell phone numbers, e-mail addresses and current personal and work phone numbers.
8. Supervise the amount of time my child spends playing video games, using the internet, using electronic devices and I will commit to monitor the quality of each.
9. Monitor my child's use of social media.
10. Check my child's academic progress regularly (Home Access Center - HAC).
11. Teach my child to respect his/her teachers and all other school personnel.
12. Encourage my child to be involved or join a campus club or extracurricular activity at the high school.

We encourage parental involvement with the following activities:

THE TEACHER'S AGREEMENT

THE STUDENT'S AGREEMENT

3. Return all assignments completed.
4. Attend tutorials as needed.
5. Follow classroom, campus and bus rules. Late bus rules will be strictly enforced students are not allowed on a bus without proper documentation.
6. Practice universally accepted behaviors such as: honesty, integrity, courtesy, justice, responsibility and respect for self and other students, teachers, administrators and all other school personnel.
